i) CHESS COMPETITION INFORMATION

1. Date and Place

The Chess competition for the Macau 2007, 2nd Asian Indoor Games will be held in Macau International Shooting Range from 26th of October to 3rd of November, 2007. This schedule is, however, subject to changes depending on the final number of entries.

2. Venues

2.1 Competition Venue

Macau International Shooting Range is located approximately 6 km from Macao city centre, with a seating capacity of over 400 and a competition area of 110m X 8m.

2.2 Training Venue

The Training will be conducted at the competition site.

3. Events

3.1 There will be 3 categories of events

Classical Chess
Rapid Chess
Blitz Chess

3.2 For each category of event, there will be mixed team competitions and individual competitions for both men and women.

i) CHESS COMPETITION INFORMATION

5. Eligibility

- 5.1 The 2nd Asian Indoor Games Chess competition is exclusive for teams representing the National Olympic Committee (NOC).
- 5.2 Only competitors who comply with the conditions integrated in OCA constitution are entitled to participate.
- 5.3 Each team representing their NOC for Chess competition, may be composed of no more than ten (10) persons – one (1) Head of Delegation; one (1) Coach; not more than four (4) Men athletes and not more than four (4) Women athletes.
- 5.4 For all the Team Events, each team shall be composed of two (2) men athletes and two (2) women athletes with one (1) man reserve and one (1) woman reserve. The athletes shall be arranged in a fixed order Men 1; Men 2; Women 1; Women 2. In any particular round, the reserve may be used to substitute an athlete who is not playing.
- 5.5 For the Classical Chess & Rapid Chess Team Event, the best two scores on each board shall qualify for the individual event provide they must have played all six (6) rounds. For Blitz Chess Individual, not more than two (2) athletes (one man and one woman) can be registered.

6. Entries

- 6.1 Entries of each participating NOC must be submitted in accordance with the regulations laid by MAIGOC.
- 6.2 Deadline for Entry Forms by number (Preliminary)
Preliminary Entry Forms by number from Technical Officials and each participating NOC, forwarded through the respective National Olympic Committee (NOC) must be completed and should be received by MAIGOC no later than **22nd of June, 2007 at 18:00 hours, Macau Local time.**
- 6.3 Deadline for Entry Forms by Name (Final)
The Entry Forms by name must be received by MAIGOC no later than **14th of September, 2007 at 18:00 hours, Macau Local time.**

The completed Entry by Name forms must be submitted for each athlete and must include all necessary information including the athlete's full name.

8. General Rules and Regulations

8.1 Competition Rules

The Chess competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest FIDE Rules. In case of translation related disagreements over the rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incident not addressed by the rules shall be resolved as follows:

- *General issues:* Resolved in accordance with the OCA Constitution.
- *Technical issues:* Resolved in accordance with the spirit of the FIDE Laws of Chess.

8.2 Duration of Competition

8.2.1 Classical Chess: 90 minutes with increment of 30 seconds per move.

8.2.2 Rapid Chess: 25 minutes with increment of 10 seconds per move.

8.2.3 Blitz Chess: 3 minutes with increment of 2 seconds per move.

8.3 Classical Chess & Rapid Chess Team

8.3.1 The teams will compete using the Swiss-System of 6 rounds.

8.3.2 Each match shall be played over four (4) boards; Men 1, Men 2, Women 1 and Women 2.

8.3.3 The scoring for each board shall be one (1) point for win; half (1/2)

point for draw and zero (0) for a loss. The total, Game Points, shall decide the result of a match – one (1) for win; half (1/2) for draw and zero (0) for loss.

- 8.3.4 The final rankings shall be decided by the number of Match Points. In case of a tie, the following order shall be considered:-

- a) number of Game Points;
- b) result of individual match between the teams tied;
- c) total sum of the Match Points of the team's opponent teams;
- d) total sum of the Game Points of the team's opponent teams;
- e) play-off match between the teams tied using Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule.

8.4 Classical Chess & Rapid Chess Individual (Men & Women)

8.4.1 From the Team Event, the best two scores on each board shall qualify for the Individual Event provided they must have played all six (6) rounds.

8.4.2 In case of a tie, the following order shall be considered:-

- a) result of individual game between the players tied;
- b) total sum of the scores of the player's opponents;
- c) playoff match between the players tied using Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule.

8.4.3 The draw for the Semi-Final:-

M1 (W1) best scorer vs M2 (W2) second best scorer

M1 (W1) second best scorer vs M2 (W2) best scorer

8.4.4 The winner of the two (2) game match shall qualify for the Final. In case of a drawn match, the Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule shall apply.

8.4.5 The Finalists shall contest a two-game match. In case of a drawn match, the Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule shall apply.

8.4.6 The two losing semi-finalists shall be awarded the Bronze Medal.

8.5 Blitz Chess Team

8.5.1 The teams will compete using the Swiss-System of 9 rounds.

8.5.2 Each match shall be played over four (4) boards; Men 1, Men 2, Women 1 and Women 2.

8.5.3 The scoring for each board shall be one (1) point for win; half (1/2) point for draw and zero (0) for a loss. The total, Game Points, shall decide the result of a match – one (1) for win; half (1/2) for draw and zero (0) for loss.

8.5.4 The final rankings shall be decided by the number of Match Points. In case of a tie, the following order shall be considered:-

- a) number of Game Points;
- b) result of individual match between the teams tied;
- c) total sum of the Match Points of the team's opponent teams;
- d) total sum of the Game Points of the team's opponent teams;

- e) play-off match between the teams tied using Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule.

8.6 Blitz Chess Individual (Men & Women)

8.6.1 The competitors shall compete using the Swiss-System of 9 rounds.

8.6.2 The four (4) best players will compete in the Semi-Final.

8.6.3 In case of a tie, the following order shall be considered:

- result of individual game between the players tied;
- total sum of the scores of the player's opponents;
- playoff match between the players tied using Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule.

8.6.4 The draw for the Semi-Final:

M1 (W1) best scorer vs M4 (W4) fourth best scorer

M2 (W2) second best scorer vs M3 (W3) third best scorer

8.6.5 The winner of the four (4) game match shall qualify for the Final.

In case of a drawn match, the Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule shall apply.

8.6.6 The Finalists shall contest a four-game match. In case of a drawn match, the Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule shall apply.

8.6.7 The two losing semi-finalists shall be awarded the Bronze Medal.

8.7 Blitz Chess Sudden Death Rule

After the draw for colours, White shall be given 6 minutes and Black given 5 minutes. In case the game ends in a draw, Black qualifies.

9. Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal

The necessary Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal for the Chess competition will be appointed by the ACF, and approved by OCA and MAIGOC. These personnel includes: one (1) Technical Delegate, one (1) Chief Arbiter, one (1) Deputy Chief Arbiter, Assistant Arbiters, three (3) Pairings Committee Members and five (5) Appeals Committee Members.

10. Claims and Protests

Claims and Protest made to the judges on the ground concerning matters of fact are decided by the Technical Committee without appeal. Appeals against other decisions of the judge or with regard to any other matter must be addressed in due time to the Chairman of the Jury of Appeal, by a representative of the Member Organization of the NOC making the appeal.

i) CHESS COMPETITION INFORMATION

Any claim must be made within thirty (30) minutes of the decision giving rise to the claim. The Jury of Appeal after an investigation shall then give a decision and this decision shall be irrevocable, except for the case of disqualification of a team or of a competitor for infraction of the Rules and Regulations of the Games, which shall be decided by the Court of Appeal. All claims and appeals must be made in writing.

Protest will be dealt with in accordance to the FIDE rules. All protests must be accompanied by a deposit of one hundred dollars (US\$100) or its equivalent. Any protest without the deposit will be considered void.

11. Uniform

All athletes participating in the chess competition will wear appropriate clothing and apparel that comply with the FIDE dress code regulations. No athlete or technical official may attach any commercial advertising to his or her competition uniform without prior agreement with OCA, FIDE and MAIGOC.

12. Competition Equipment

Sport equipment will be in accordance with the specification set by FIDE Rules and Regulations.

13. Penalties in Case of Fraud

A competitor proved fraudulently to have transgressed the Rules and Regulations of the Games Federation, shall be disqualified and lose any position he/she may have gained. If this competitor's Member Organization is proven to have been a party to the fraud, his/her NOC shall be disqualified in the sport involved.

14. Withdrawal

An accepted athlete or team cannot withdraw except for reasons for sickness or injury. A request to withdraw must be supported by an official physician's certificate. All decisions must be approved by the Chief Arbiter and the Technical Delegate.

9. Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal

The necessary Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal for the Xiangqi competition will be appointed by the AXF, and approved by OCA and MAIGOC. These personnel include: one (1) Technical Delegate, one (1) Chief Referee, three (3) Deputy Chief Referees, ten (10) Assistant Referees, one (1) Chairman of the Jury and seven (7) Jury Members.

Chairman of the Jury and Jury Members will be elected during the Team Managers Meeting on 26th of October, 2006.

10. Claims and Protests

Claims and Protest made to the judges on the ground concerning matters of fact are decided by the Jury Committee without appeal. Appeals against other decisions of the judge or with regard to any other matter must be addressed in due time to the Chairman of the Jury, by a representative of the Member Organization of the NOC making the appeal.

Any claim must be made within twenty-four (24) hours of the decision giving rise to the claim. The Jury of Appeal after an investigation shall then give a decision and this decision shall be irrevocable, except for the case of disqualification of a team or of a competitor for infraction of the Rules and Regulations of the Games, which shall be decided by the Court of Appeal. All claims and appeals must be made in writing.

Protest will be dealt with in accordance to the AXF rules. All protests must be accompanied by a deposit of one hundred dollars (US\$100) or its equivalent. Any protest without the deposit will be considered void.

11. Uniform

No athlete or technical official may attach any form of commercial advertising to his or her competition uniform without prior agreement with OCA, AXF and MAIGOC.

12. Competition Equipment

Sport equipment will be in accordance with the specification set by AXF Rules and Regulations.

13. Withdrawal

An accepted athlete or team cannot withdraw except for reasons for sickness or injury. A request to withdraw must be supported by an official physician's certificate. All decisions must be approved by the Chief Referee and the Technical Delegate.

14. Penalties in Case of Fraud

A competitor proved fraudulently to have transgressed the Rules and Regulations of the Games Federation, shall be disqualified and lose any position he/she may have gained. If this competitor's Member Organization is proven to have been a party to the fraud, his/her NOC shall be disqualified in the sport involved.

15. Prizes

15.1 Language

Chinese and English will be used for the Victory Ceremony.

15.2 Clothing

All awardees must wear their NOC's official clothing.

15.3 Order of Awards

The medals will be called out and conferred in following order: 3rd, 2nd, 1st

iii) DOPING CONTROL/GENDER VERIFICATION

1. Doping Control

Doping control for all events of the Macau 2007, 2nd Asian Indoor Games will be conducted according to OCA Medical Committee directions and will follow the procedures specified by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

2. Gender verification

Gender verification tests may be carried out in accordance with the OCA Constitution and Rules.

3. Competitor who is chosen to be tested will be notified after the match. When notified, the competitor must proceed to the Doping Centre within an hour for examination. The competitor must bring an AD / ID Card. Those who are notified, but do not arrive at the centre will be treated as testing positive. Competitor must be either accompanied by coach or team doctor. Gender examination will take place only when needed.

V. INTRODUCTION TO MACAO S.A.R.

1. Location & Area

Macao Special Administrative Region is located on the southeastern coast of China, at latitude 22°14' North and longitude 113°35' East. The territory comprises a peninsula and two islands in the Pearl River Delta of Guangdong Province.

The total area of Macao is 27.5 km² the peninsula has 8.8 km², Taipa 6.4 km², Coloane 7.6 km² and the reclaimed land between Taipa and Coloane has 4.7 km².

The city of Macao is built on the peninsula; three bridges of 2.2 km, 2.5 km and 4.5 km respectively link it to its nearest island of Taipa, which in turn is joined with Coloane by a 2.2 km-long causeway. At the extreme northern end of the peninsula, on a narrow isthmus, is the imposing gateway (Portas do Cerco, or Border Gate), that leads to the Zhuhai and Zhongshan areas of China.

2. Time

Macao is eight hours ahead of GMT.

3. Population

Macao's population is around 500,000 residents, of which about 95% of its population are Chinese and 5% are Portuguese, Europeans and from other countries.

The majority of the population lives in the Macao peninsula. The two islands are places devoid of the hustle and bustle of the city centre, especially Coloane which is the garden of the Territory with lots of parks and greenery areas.

4. Language

Chinese and Portuguese are the official languages, with Cantonese being most widely spoken. English is generally used in trade, tourism and commerce.

V. INTRODUCTION TO MACAO S.A.R.

5. Currency

The Pataca (MOP) is Macao's official currency. There are bank notes and coins in the following denominations: Bank notes: 10, 20, 50, 100, 500 and 1,000 Patacas. Coins: 1, 2, 5 and 10 Patacas; 10, 20 and 50 avos. By the decision of the Macao Government, the Pataca is pegged to the Hong Kong dollar (HKD) and Renminbi (RMB), which freely circulate in Macao. The exchange rates are MOP\$103=HK\$100, MOP\$100.5=RMB\$100. There is an acceptable variation up to 10%. Roughly 8 Patacas is equivalent to 1 US dollar.

Foreign currency or travelers' checks can be easily changed in hotels, banks and authorized exchange dealers located all around the city. If the visitor needs to change money outside the usual working hours, there are 24 hours exchange counters operating in the Macao International Airport (Taipa Island) and in the Lisboa Hotel (Macao). Banks open normally from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. through lunchtime. Most credit cards are accepted in many hotels, shops and restaurants. There are no restrictions on the amount of currency that can be brought in or taken out.

VI. WEATHER CONDITIONS

1. Climate

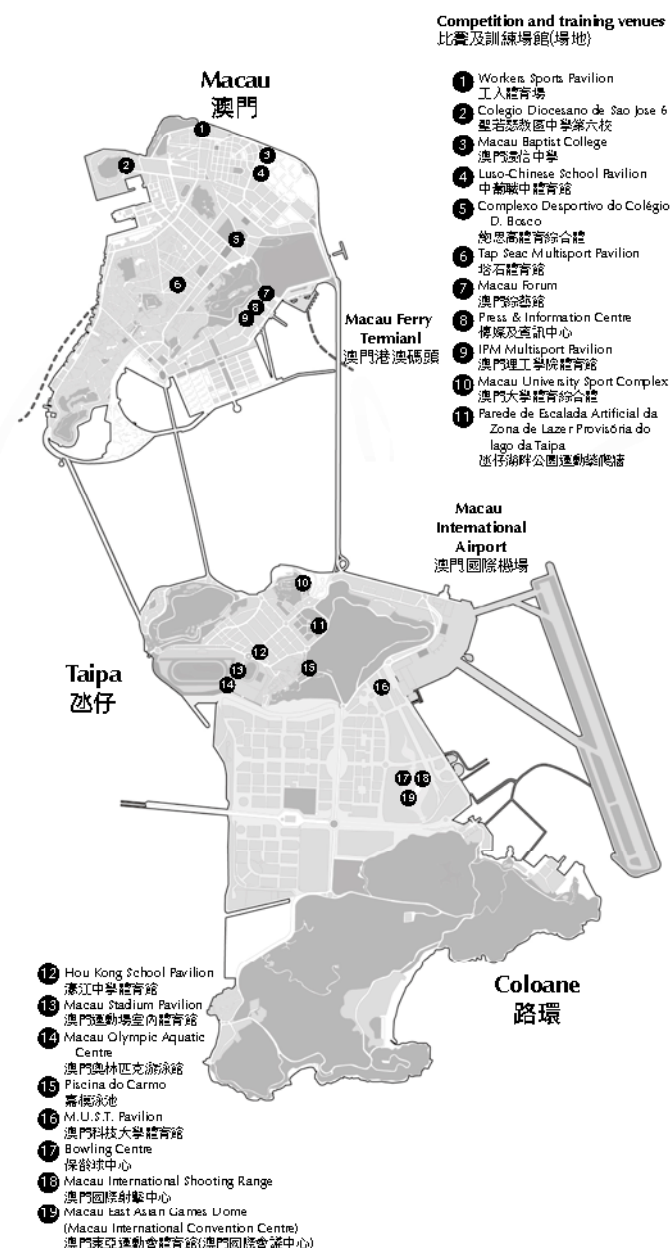
The climate is moderate to hot, with an average annual temperature of just over 20°C (68°F) and a yearly mean variation between 15°C (59°F) and 28°C (82.4°F). The humidity is high with an average range between 68% and 87%. The yearly rainfall is about 2,100 mm. The best period to visit Macao is between October and December, when days are sunny and warm, and the humidity low. The winter is cold but sunny. In April, the humidity becomes apparent and from May to September the climate is hot and humid with rain and occasional tropical storms (typhoons). 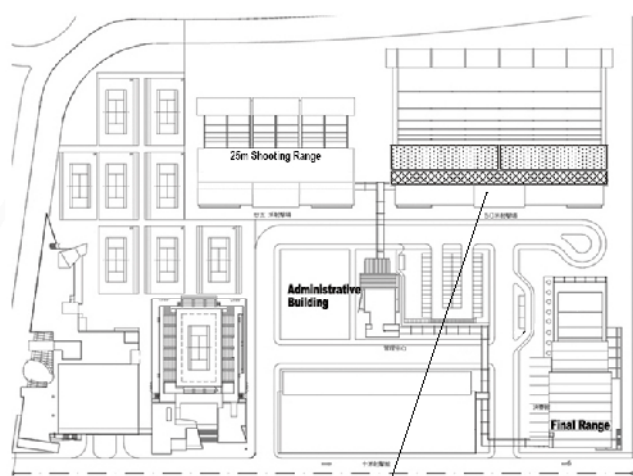

V. 澳門特別行政區簡介

1. 地理位置及面積

澳門特別行政區位於中國東南沿海廣東省珠江三角洲，在北緯22°14'、東經113°35'。澳門由澳門半島、氹仔和路環兩個離島組成。總面積共27.5平方公里，其中澳門半島8.8平方公里、氹仔6.4平方公里、路環7.6平方公里、路氹填海區4.7平方公里。澳門半島是澳門之中心地帶，它與氹仔之間由一條分別長2.2公里、2.5公里及4.5公里的澳氹大橋連接；氹仔和路環之間也有一條約2.2公里的路氹連貫公路相連。經澳門半島最北面的關閘可到達中國的珠海市和中山市。

2. 時間

澳門的時間比格林威治標準時間早八小時。

3. 人口

澳門總人口約500,000人，其中95%為華人，葡國人及其他外國人只約佔5%。大部份居民住在澳門半島，兩個離島並不如市中心般充滿緊張的氣氛，特別是路環，四周充滿大量公園及綠化植物，可說是城市的綠洲。

4. 語言

中文和葡文是現行官方語言，居民日常溝通使用廣州話，英語在澳門也很廣泛應用於貿易、旅遊、商業用途。

5. 貨幣

澳門的官方貨幣單位是澳門幣(PATACA)。紙幣面額計有10元、20元、50元、100元、500元及1,000元六種；硬幣有1毫、2毫、5毫、1元、2元、5元和10元七種。在澳門售賣的商品和所提供的服務收費一律以澳門幣計算，但也可使用人民幣及港幣。港幣100元約兌換澳門幣103元；人民幣100元約兌換澳門幣100.5元。兌換率按市場浮動率釐定，而1美元約兌換澳門幣8元。

銀行、酒店或銀號均提供兌換外幣和旅行支票的服務，而且地點適中，十分方便。另外，澳門國際機場和葡京酒店內提供二十四小時兌換外幣服務。

本地銀行營業時間為早上九時至下午五時一十分，信用卡也可以在澳門部份商店流通使用。本地或外地貨幣可自由出入境，數量不限。

VI. 氣象資料

1. 氣候

澳門全年氣候溫和至炎熱，平均氣溫約20°C (68°F)，全年溫度變化在16°C (50°F)至25°C (77°F)之間；濕度較高，約73%至90%；全年降雨量約2,100毫米。

10月至12月為澳門旅遊的理想季節，氣候溫和，濕度低。冬季雖較寒冷，但陽光普照；踏入4月，濕度逐漸上升；5月至9月，天氣炎熱及潮濕，有時有雨及颱風。澳門2007年第二屆亞洲室內運動會(10月至11月)期間之預計天氣狀況如下：

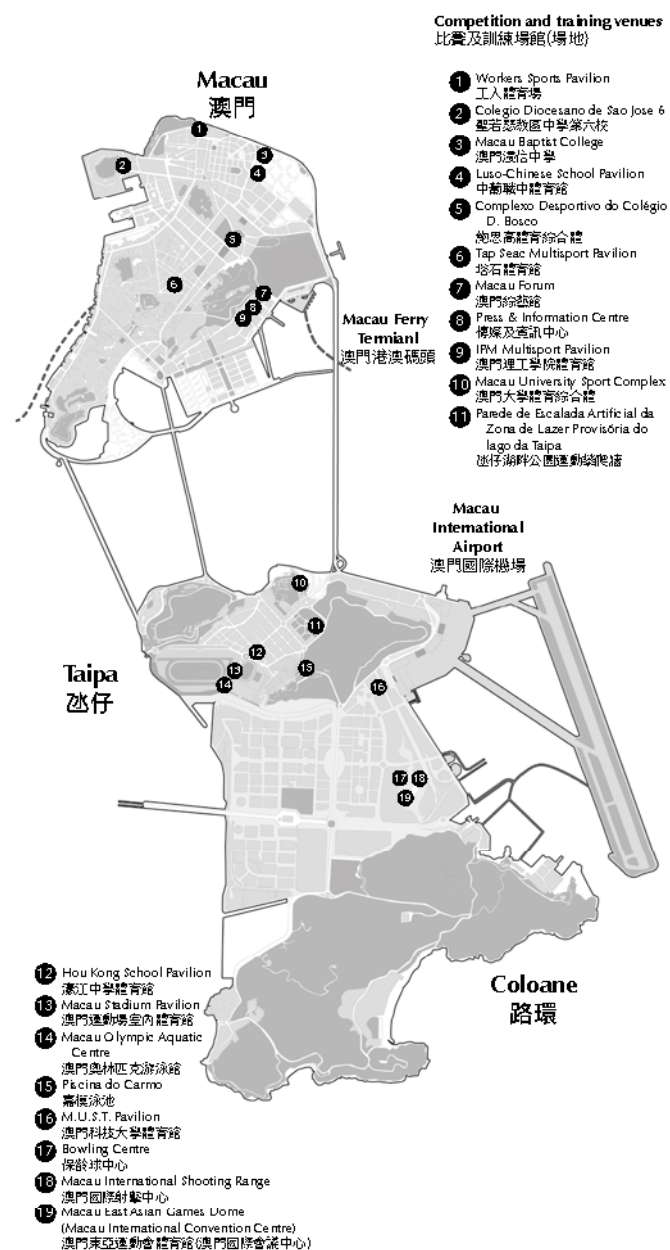

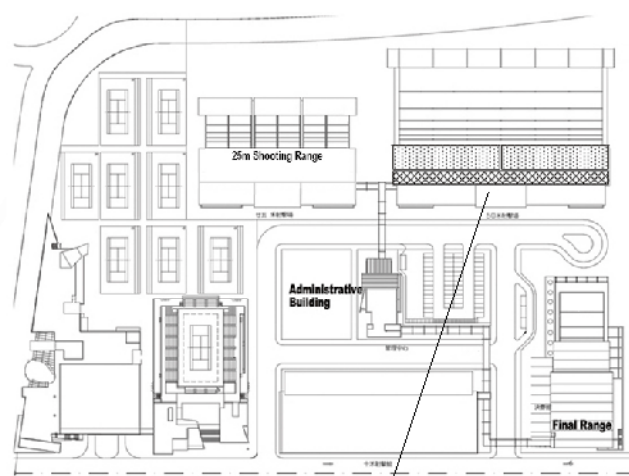
